Introduction

Dr Charles Paton Parry gained a Certificate in Psychological Medicine in 1890. He went on to be a general practitioner in Carmarthen. He was from a family of psychiatrists and his brother was the chaplain at Colney Hatch Asylum in London.

The ticket and accompanying notes on family history were gifted to LHSA by Dr Patrick Mullin, Dr Parry's great nephew.
